Yes, the Childhood Language Center is a 501(3)c, eligible charity and your donations is 100% tax deductible.

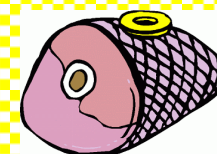
Does All of the Money That you Donate Go to Support the Stockton Center?
